**The Regional Consumer Advisory Council (RCAC)** anticipates receiving funds from the CT Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services in which to award mini-grants of up to **\$2,000**. To apply, you must be an adult 18 + years old, in recovery from a psychiatric and/or addiction disorder, maintained one-year of recovery and a resident of North Central CT.

*Projects must support at least one of the following:*

1. **Advocacy** among adults in recovery from psychiatric or substance-use disorders.
2. **Leadership** among adults in recovery from psychiatric and/or substance-use disorders.
3. **Integration** through an activity / event promoting mutual understanding of psychiatric / substance-use disorders.
4. **Education** through a conference / forum using topics which benefit adults in recovery from psychiatric and/or substance-use disorders.
5. **Technology:** Software, hardware or training.

**Applicants require the support of a fiduciary from a non-profit organization with tax exempt 501c3 status. If you are unable to recruit such a fiduciary, please contact NCRMHB's RCAC staff for assistance.**
